Updated July 2015

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• In 2014, Kansas City was the 40th largest metropolitan area exporter in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$8.3 billion. This is up \$251 million (3.1 percent) from the \$8.0 billion in merchandise exported in 2013.

• In 2012 (latest data available), 2,088 companies exported goods from the Kansas City metropolitan area. Of these, 1,758 were small- or medium-sized exporters (SMEs) with fewer than 500 employees.

• Counties from the Kansas City metropolitan area that reported exports in 2014 included: Johnson County (\$3.0 billion), Jackson County (\$2.0 billion), Clay County (\$1.7 billion), Platte County (\$685 million), Wyandotte County (\$658 million), Ray County (\$86 million), Lafayette County (\$27 million), Cass County (\$21 million), Miami County (\$18 million), Leavenworth County (\$15 million).

• In 2014, Kansas City's top export markets included Canada (\$2.5 billion), Mexico (\$2.0 billion), China (\$828 million), Japan (\$413 million), and Germany (\$339 million).

• Top export sectors from Kansas City in 2014 were agricultural products (\$1.9 billion); transportation equipment (\$1.8 billion); chemicals (\$1.3 billion); processed foods (\$875 million); and computer & electronic products (\$816 million). Kansas City is also a major metropolitan area exporter of beverages and tobacco products; fabricated metal products; petroleum and coal products; printed matter and related products; and leather and allied products.

• In 2014, Kansas City benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting 59.5 percent of merchandise exports to free trade agreement (FTA) partners.

• In 2014, Kansas City exported \$4.5 billion in goods to the NAFTA region and \$57 million in goods to the CAFTA-DR region.
